K-2 students went outside to choose some pretty fall leaves. They were encouraged to pick up leaves with an unusual shape and color. Then they created their own fall tree. The students showed the multi-colors of leaves during fall.



Grades 3-5 used their senses when carving their pumpkin suggesting words to describe, the pumpkin's appearance, smell, and taste. They also explored the inside pulp and seeds. The students predicted the number of seeds inside the pumpkin and then compared their estimate to the actual final count. They also painted halves of apples orange to create a pumpkin stencil.

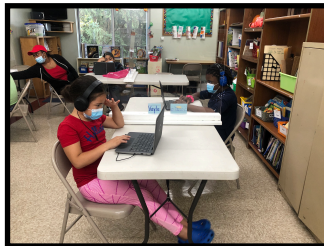
